The Regular Meeting of the White Township Board of Education was held via Google Meet on the above date with the following members in attendance at roll call: Ms. Nusser-Meany, Ms. Howell, Mr. Havlusch, Mrs. Williams and Mr. Panetta. William Thompson, CSA and Dawn Huff, Business Administrator/Board Secretary were also in attendance as well as one member of the public. Mrs. Lensi, Mr. Murray, Mrs. Smith and Mrs. Sroka were unable to attend.

Mr. Panetta opened the meeting at 6:40 p.m. and stated that in accordance with the State's Sunshine Law, adequate notice of this meeting was provided (by sending a notice of the time, date, instructions for remote access and making public comment) to the NJ Herald and Express Times on December 15, 2020.
