In the spring, your child participated in the New Jersey State Learning Assessment (NJSLA) for ELA and Math to measure his or her academic progress with the New Jersey Student Learning Standards. Evaluating the results from NJSLA testing can be a helpful tool in measuring your child's success in school. New Jersey has had statewide tests for decades, and they serve as one measure in assessing our students' annual progress by helping to determine if students are on track to being college and career ready.

The results from NJSLA testing is encouraging as students at White Township School perform well when compared to their peers around the state. Attached are Individual Student Reports for both English Language Arts and Mathematics. A written explanation indicates where your child is doing well and where he or she may need additional help. There are also charts and graphics that show you how well your child is performing in relation to the New Jersey Student Learning Standards ([www.state.nj.us/education/cccs/](http://www.state.nj.us/education/cccs/)), and how your child's performance compares to other students in his or her school, district, and state.
