I hope this letter finds you and your family well. Please know we are working to finalize homeroom lists and schedules as we balance in-person and virtual learning for our students. At the beginning of next week, we plan on mailing key information to you for the start of the school year. Information will include your child's homeroom teacher for the 20-21 school year, busing times for pick up and drop off, COVID-19 protocols, and other useful information to help ensure a safe, smooth start for our students.

In fostering a safe environment for all, please keep Governor Murphy's travel advisory in mind as the school year draws closer. The travel advisory expects individuals who have traveled to a state on the advisory list to quarantine for 14 days. In recognition of this travel advisory, our School District will expect that any families who have traveled to a state on the list will quarantine for 14 days, which will exclude them from in-person learning during the quarantine timeframe.
