

Project Positivity Restarting on October 9th 4:30-6:30!!!

The PTO will be starting up Project Positivity again on October 9th.

What is Project Positivity? This is something we do for the students! Parents, guardians & school staff paint positive messages in the hallways to inspire our children and brighten the hallways! We began this project last spring and have painted a lot of messages on the first floor. This year we begin phase 2 and we will be moving to the second floor for hallway painting. Phase 3 will be painting messages in the bathrooms on both floors.

How does it work? We have a list of inspirational messages to paint – volunteers have creative license to come up with designs or to copy the sample design. You do not need to be artistic to help! We work for about 2 hours per session which allows you time to paint at least one message and clean up. You can work by yourself, as a duo or a group. It's up to you. The more people we have to help the more quickly we can get through phase 2 and get to phase 3. We schedule sessions about once a month from 4:00-6:00 or 5:00-7:00 (sometimes we need to make slight adjustments due to scheduling challenges).

We have some painting supplies left from last year, however, if you have paint to donate or stencils, we can always use them! **ALL paints must be in new, or slightly used condition. Please check paint before dropping off and do not send old, clumpy paint or nearly empty cans.**

- Quart-sized or color sample size paint in any color (wall paint)
- Gallon-sized paint in solid colors only such as white, black, red (wall/ceiling paint)
- Acrylic craft paints in any color
- Stencils that can be re-used – flowers, hearts, ABC letters, positive messages, sports-related, animals
- Any other supplies that you think would be helpful
